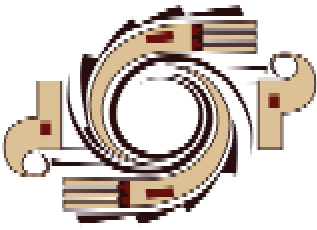

Papers not conforming to the guidelines will not be published and may not be eligible for presentation at the convention.
